

While I fully agree that our whole pension legislation is open to criticism, and am entirely in accord with the sentiment expressed in your World's Work article, that the trouble with our pension system is the policy of piecemeal legislation which has been followed for so many years, it is obvious that in any comprehensive and final adjustment of the whole question, the claims of all should be fairly heard.

Turning now to your letter, I trust that you will not have considered my silence as implying consent to the justice or propriety of some of your comments which I deem a reflection upon the patriotism and self-sacrifice of loyal citizens of my State during the Civil War.

The second paragraph of your letter reads as follows:

"As you and I know perfectly well, the case of the Delaware Volunteers is purely and simply a case of an organization which enjoyed a very pleasant summer picnic,—an open air life in an agreeable country; fifty years ago!"

Please understand that I know nothing of the kind; but, on the contrary, that I have positive information that the duty of the 5th and 6th Delaware volunteers in the summer of 1863, though short, was very onerous and disagreeable. The services performed by these troops at that time, consisted in garrisoning Fort Delaware, Del., and guarding the many thousands of Confederate prisoners confined there, and in protecting the Philadelphia, Wilmington and Baltimore Railroad and the Chesapeake and Delaware Canal north from Baltimore, both of which were the main lines of communication and supply between the North and the South on the Atlantic seaboard. This was of vital necessity to the government, as the local secessionists in Delaware and Maryland would have blown up the canal locks and destroyed the railroad bridges and ferry across the Susquehanna had they not been guarded.

The duty at Fort Delaware was severe and the locality insalubrious, with the result that many typhoid fever cases developed in the command, causing a number of deaths. Further, the country along the railroad and canal was very largely malarial and plagued with mosquitoes, so that the "picnic" to which you refer exists only in imagination.

The troops which they relieved along the railroad were the 5th New York Heavy Artillery which afterwards was sent to the 6th Corps and served in the battles in the Shenandoah Valley.

You next state: "You and I or any young fellow would have been glad then, or would be glad now, to participate in such an outing."

Of course, I cannot speak for you, but as far as I am concerned, with my personal knowledge of the localities, I should be very sorry to participate in such an outing if pleasure alone were to be considered. The men who composed the 5th and 6th Delaware regiments were not all young fellows, as you seem to think, setting out for an agreeable diversion, but men who almost without exception made serious sacrifices in leaving their homes, and this can be best explained by considering the local conditions which then obtained.

At the beginning of the war nearly one-half of the people of Delaware, who called themselves Democrats, were sympathizers with the Southern cause, as that State was one of the former slave-holding States. A few of them carried the courage of their convictions sufficiently far to leave the State and go South to fight in the Confederate army, as did the Delaware representative in the United States Military Academy, a resident of Wilmington; but the great majority of them remained at home and contented themselves with denouncing the general government and the war. Many threats were made to destroy the lines of communication between the North and the South, as well as certain industrial establishments which were of supreme importance to the government. These threats extended in many localities to the individual property and personal security of Union men. Because of its disloyalty the State Militia, instead of being called out, was disbanded, and the Legislature of the State refused to vote a single dollar for bounties, but granted liberal appropriations for hiring substitutes to take the places of those who were drafted.

The census reports show that when hostilities began, the number of white males in the State of Delaware between 18 and 45, of age for military service, was 18,273, of which number 9,500 is a fair estimate of those who were loyal. Subtracting therefrom ten per cent, which approximates to the number of those who were physically unable to service, we have 8,550 men, and from these must be deducted those who enlisted in the Navy and Marine Corps and in the Regular Army, which would reduce this figure by at least 800 men, leaving about 8,250.
